Dr. N. Rajendran welcomed the gathering with an introduction about the Newspaper reading. He stated that if newspaper reading used in an inspiring way, it help students not only to develop reading skills but also enable them to write without grammatical errors. He also added that reading newspapers improve word power as well.





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Prof. V. Balaji encouraged students to read newspapers. Also he stated that reading newspapers is an important habit in today's world, since it provides us with minute data about our surroundings - everything linked to the present, significant influence of previous events, and also aids us in predicting or dreaming about the future. Reading newspapers serve to improve a person's intellectual, hence it should be done with enthusiasm and fervor.



Reading Newspapers in classrooms will improve Reading and Listening skills. "UllathuUllapadi" Tamil newspaper was circulated among the students. The students were highly interested in reading it.





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Three students were instructed to read the Newspaper. The Principal gave several tips for effective reading.

(Some of the Future Activities planned in Newspaper Reading)

### **Guess the headline**

Cut out a number of headlines and from each one remove an interesting word (e.g. Missing Painting Found In \_\_\_\_\_ ). Stick the incomplete headlines on a piece of paper, photocopy and distribute to teams of 3-4 students. Ask each team to come up with two possible answers for each headline: the most likely word and the funniest word. Collect all the responses and give each team a point for any correct answer, and for the funniest answers. Get everyone involved by holding a vote for the funniest / most original answer for each headline.

### **Guess the article**

Select an interesting newspaper article, preferably one which involves an exciting / unusual story. Choose eight key words from the article and write them on the board. Ask students to work in teams of 3-4 to come up with a story including these words. When



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they have finished, read out / tell them about the original article. Get students to read aloud their own versions - this can create a lot of laughs!

### **Newspaper lies**

Ask students to select a short item of news and to summarize it to a partner / team, changing some of the details. Partners need to try and guess which of the facts are true and which have been changed.

### **Wall quiz**

Write a list of questions based on a selection of newspaper articles, and distribute the quiz to teams of 2-3 students. Pin up the articles around the room and ask students to walk around the room trying to find the answers. The winning team is the first to find all the answers. This can be quite a lively activity!

### **Presentations**

To encourage students to read newspapers in English on a more regular basis, organise short presentations at the beginning of each class. Ask a different student at the end of each class to find an interesting newspaper article and to summarise it to the other students during the next class, explaining why they chose it. This can lead to interesting discussions about current issues.

### **Newspaper treasure hunt**

For this activity you will need a pile of old newspapers, enough to distribute amongst teams of 4-5 students. Write a list of articles / words / pictures which the students need to find, and give teams a copy of the list. Tell them to cut out their 'treasures' and glue them next to the appropriate word in the list (or make a note of the page number). Possible list:



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- A job advert
- Some good news
- Some bad news
- Reference to a famous political figure
- News about a star
- Weather forecast
- News about a sport
- Name of a country
- Favourite news item
- Gossip

This is an easy activity for helping students to summarize articles. For this activity it is best to use tabloid newspapers or articles involving a bit of scandal, perhaps about famous people. Teach students useful phrases for chatting or gossiping, e.g. 'Have you heard about...?', 'Did you know that...?', 'Guess what?' etc. Use appropriate gestures and intonation. Ask students to choose an article of their choice, underline or jot down important parts of the article and report it to a friend, as though having an informal chat. They could then go round the class, chatting with different people about their news article. You could also teach students some useful phrases for responding, e.g. 'Really? I don't believe it!', 'Are you joking?', 'How / when did it happen?'

### News programmes

This is a great team activity for both reading and speaking practice. Put students into small teams and give them one or two recent newspapers. Tell them that they are going to work together to produce a news programme, including the headlines, special reports, interviews, perhaps some footage from a story (if students like acting!), perhaps the weather forecast. Their programme should be based on news items from the papers, and everyone must be involved in some way. If you have the equipment, you might like to film the programmes, or if not, each team could act out their programme to the rest of the class)

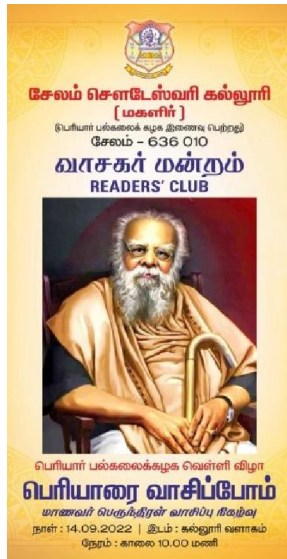




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On 14.9.2022 at 10 am in front of Ayya J.K.K. AngappaChettiar statue, Salem Sowdeswari Women's College, all the students were seated in rows at regular intervals and then the principal of the college Prof. V. Balaji addressed the gathering with a short introduction about Periyar.





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He pointed out that Periyar University was started in the year 1997. He explained about Periyar's social welfare work for the Tamil community and his work to create a caste-less society. Later, the college Principal also spoke about the relationship of late Dr. J.K.K. AngappaChettiar, the first secretary and Correspondent of Salem Sowdeswari College, with Periyar. He also pointed out that "Periyar Valaivu" located in Gugai, Trichy Main Road in Salem, was established by Dr. J.K.K. AngappaChettiar.



He said that the works done by Periyar for the advancement of women cannot be measured. The event "PeriyaraiVasippom" is the first programme in which all the students participated (Aided & Self finance) after our college has been converted into a women's college from this academic year.

**INAUGURATION OF READERS' CLUB**

The Readers' club of Salem Sowdeswari College (for Women) was inaugurated on 15.10.2022 at College Library Building. The aim of the Readers' club is to cultivate the knowledge and skills through reading. Reading maketh man to attain wisdom.

Dr. N. Rajendran, Coordinator of the Readers' club addressed the gathering. He has presented the following information: The aim of the Readers' Club is to enhance the



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reading aptitude among students. It has decided to conduct the meeting of the club once in a week and the students are assigned to present a book in each meeting. Readers' Club Library is a service initiative to support and promote Book reading habit. It improves discipline and one of the greatest stress busters. It Inspires us to work hard and achieve things in life. More than 50 students came forward to write articles in different languages i.e. Kannada, English, Hindi, Konkani, Sanskrit etc. Competitions like Book review writing, reading comprehension, storytelling, literary quiz, spot poetry writing, etc. are to be conducted periodically

Mr. S. Jegan, Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil presented the Welcome address. The following are some of his valuable points: Reading focuses on how to recognize words and pronounce them. Reading habit is to understand specific information in the text was also important. Researchers have continued to study reading and have developed a broader understanding of what reading is and how it can be made fun and enjoyable. Reading is essential and serves as a basic building block for learning, regardless of the school subject, it is language, arts or even maths. In daily life, the need to read a thing such as street signs or prescriptions proves reading is also an important life skill. Reading strengthens the Brain and improves memory.

Dr. C. Nanda Kumar, Head and Associate Professor, Department of Statistics gave a lecture on developing reading skills. He has shared the following important instructions for promoting reading skill: Students of Readers Club are eligible to take maximum of five books at a time. Title, Abstract keywords, Introduction, Experimental section and Discussion are essential to engage the attention of the reader in research papers. Step by step instructions for reading a primary research article are to begin by reading the introduction, read critically, read creatively, make notes as you read the paper, summarize the paper in few sentences, If possible compare with other paper or works.

~Pronounce letters correctly;



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- ~ Pronounce words correctly;
- ~ Read sentences out loud and with accuracy;
- ~ Read sentences out loud and with expression;
- ~ Read several sentences and/or paragraphs out loud with accuracy and expression.

It improves mind concentration, focus and more confident. Followed by the reading, discussions are to be conducted which encourage listeners to construct more than literal meaning to connect with ideas within and beyond text. Reading skill enhances the vocabulary of the readers.

Mr. S. Kumar, Faculty in charge, delivered the Vote of Thanks to the gathering. His valuable points are as follow: Reading is one of the best habits of mankind to achieve progress in life. Reading novels help to expand vocabulary and expose us to different sentence structures. Read extensively but highlight vocabulary/ grammar that you don't understand or that you want to learn. Keep reading for one chapter and mark the difficult or new words that you want to learn and continue with the next chapter.

- ~ The goal of the Readers Club is to read and talk in English.
- ~ Members do not learn to read—they practice reading and talking.
- ~ Club meetings are fun, interesting, and supportive.

~ Club meetings encourage Members to read and talk about a text or a visual in English.
