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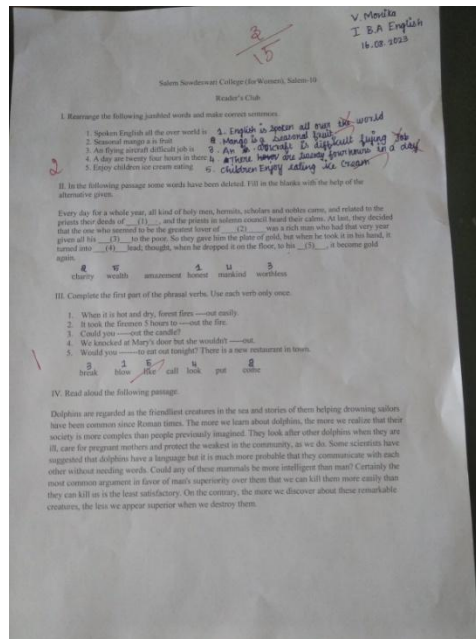
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On 16.08.23, the assessment test was conducted in I B.A English classroom at 2.30 p.m. The test was monitored by Dr. V.Thilagavathi,

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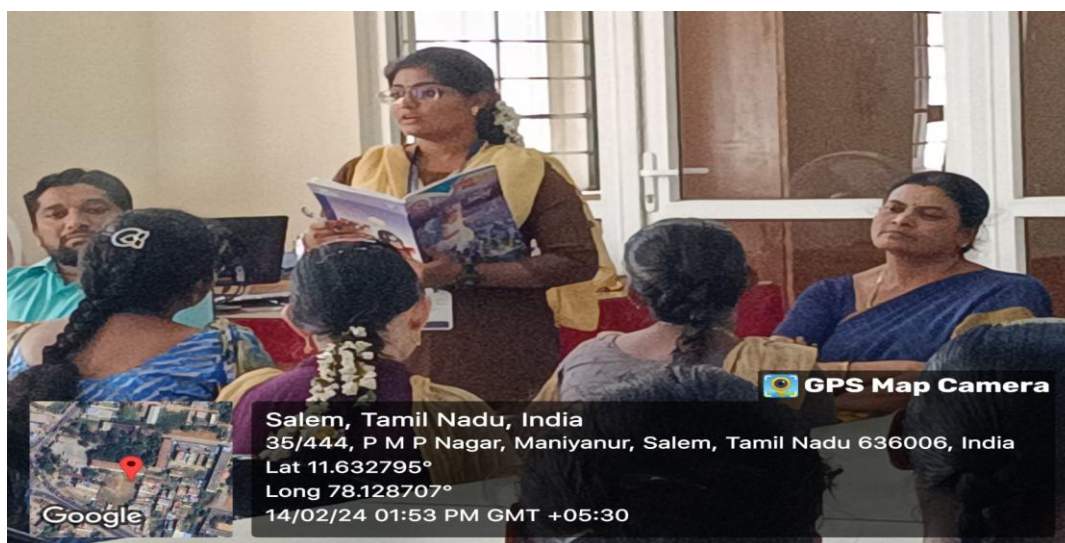
